Direct Primary Care Easily Passes House

The Florida House on Thursday overwhelmingly approved a bill that would clear the way for doctors and patients to enter into "direct primary care" agreements. The bill (HB 161), which passed in a 107-6 vote, is backed by physician and small-business

groups. Under direct primary-care agreements, patients would make regular payments to physicians to cover routine care, cutting out the role of insurers. Click here to continue reading.
