Fifteenth Judicial Circuit Seeking Physicians

The Fifteenth Judicial Circuit is seeking medical doctors to serve as members of Guardianship Examining Committees. A three-member examining committee, consisting of at least one psychiatrist or other physician, is appointed by a judge following the filing of a Petition for Guardianship. A capacity examination is conducted at a mutually convenient time for the medical professional and the alleged incapacitated person. Within 15 days after the capacity examination has taken place, the medical professional will file a report with the Court. The medical professional is paid \$350 per evaluation. We strongly encourage you to apply and become involved in the local judicial system while assisting those in the community.
