**William S. Slomka, MD, F.A.C.S.**

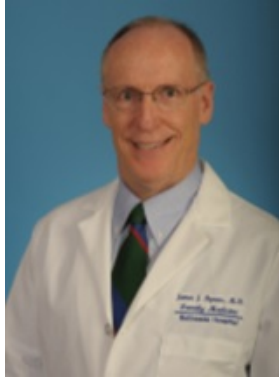
