Physician Leadership Academy (PLA) of South Florida

The PLA experience will help physicians who want to build and/or improve their leadership skills. Interactive classes will enable physicians to enhance organizational management skills, develop continuing relationships with colleagues and strengthen their leadership roles on healthcare teams in the diverse communities of South Florida. The program will include six sessions. Effective physician leadership continues to be critical as healthcare systems evolve. With attendance at all sessions, the Physician Leadership Academy will offer participants:

- At least 30 AMA Category 1 CME credits (with full attendance)
- A diverse array of leadership skills training
- Vital information about health care issues
- Access to a growing professional network
