### **Responsibilities of Board Members as Defined by PBCMS Bylaws**

- Serve as the governing body of the Medical Society
- Attend bi-monthly Board of Directors meetings
- Act upon charges against members of the Medical Society upon which the Board of Censors and Mediation has found probable cause
- Receive and consider reports from committee chairs and board members
- Appoint delegates to the state, national, foreign and medical scientific societies, except to the FMA and AMA which are provided by Bylaws
- Be responsible for interpretation of Bylaws
- Approve appointments to all committees with appointed members
- Fill vacancies of elected office for unexpired term

### **All interested applicants need to submit a letter to include the following:**

- Why you want to be a board member
- What skills/talents would you bring
- Past leadership experience
- What are your goals as a committee member
